He conducts lectures on various aspects of management (including change management, strategic management, human resources development, leadership, negotiations, motivation and counseling, knowledge management, and other related soft management skills) to Armed Forces personnel both at the national and international levels. While serving in the United Nations Peacekeeping Force in Eritrea and Ethiopia in East Africa, he was involved in conducting training programs in leadership and management for United Nations staff.
