LATEST DEPENDENT PASS REQUIREMENTS BY THE IMMIGRATION DEPARTMENT - CAWANGAN EMGS

1. PURPOSE

1.1 The purpose of this bulletin is to notify all Education Institutions regarding the latest requirements imposed by the Immigration Department - Cawangan EMGS for dependent pass applications.

2. IMPLEMENTATION

- 2.1. The Immigration Department Cawangan EMGS has updated the requirements of passport pages, physical passport photos, offer letters (from the principal applicant), confirmation letter from school/letter of oath, proof of financial support and Immigration forms.
- 2.2. With immediate effect, Education Institutions are required to submit these documents to EMGS at the following stages:

2.2.1. Application stage

- Certified True Copy (CTC) of dependent's full passport pages Education
 Institutions are required to submit the dependent's full passport pages with the
 original certified true copy stamp for all new dependent pass applications.
- Passport Photos Education Institutions are required to provide two physical passport photos for both dependent new and renewal application.
- Offer letter Education Institutions are required to submit a copy of principal applicant's offer letter.
- School's Confirmation Letter / Letter of Oath (Surat Akuan Sumpah) The
 Immigration department has advised that the children aged between 7 and 18
 years old are required to attend school. The Immigration department requires
 all dependents to provide a confirmation letter from the school or a letter of
 oath if the applicants are not currently attending school.

2.2.2. Passport endorsement stage

• **Proof of Financial Support** – Education Institutions are required to submit an original stamped letter from the bank which shows an average end of month balance of RM 10,000 for the last 3 months.

Immigration forms – All the Immigration Forms (IM12, IM55D, and IM38 forms)
 must be signed by the applicant. The parents/guardians for children aged 7
 years and below can sign the forms on behalf of the applicant.

2.3. Attached together with this bulletin is a copy of the revised checklist for dependent pass applications. Kindly note that Education Institutions also can view the updated dependent checklist via STARS > Apply Now.

Notes:

- > Children accompanying their parents MUST have individual passports.
- > The applicant cannot share passport with the principal (student).
- > The following type of passports are not acceptable:
 - Diplomatic
 - Official
 - Refugee
 - Temporary
 - Emergency passport
- Institutions can only submit the dependant passport once the principal's student pass has been issued by the Malaysian Immigration Department.
- If you send us a document that is not in English or Bahasa Malaysia in support of your application, this document must be accompanied by a full translation into English that can be independently verified by EMGS. The translation can be done by the embassy or the Institut Terjemahan & Buku Malaysia (ITBM).

If the document was translated by Translation Company. The original translation must contain:

- Confirmation from the translator or translation company that it is an accurate translation of the original document.
- The date of the translation
- The full name and signature of the translator or of an authorised official of the translation company; and the translator or translation company's contact details.
- Must be attested by the embassy.

Disclaimer: The application is subject to approval by the Malaysian Immigration Department. The Immigration Department of Malaysia reserves the right to request for any additional documents that not listed in the checklist.
